## Safety Guidelines

Your safety and the safety of our campers remains our priority! In order to maintain the highest level of safety possible for everyone, please abide by the following safety guidelines:

1. Stay within an arms reach of your camper at all times.
2. Stay with the group at all times with your camper. Do not be alone with your camper at any time. There must be a Leader, Co-Leader or Counselor with you and your camper at all times.
3. Report ANY injury to your camper or to yourself to your leader immediately.
4. Follow your leader's instructions at all times.
5. Inform your leader of any issues that may arise with your camper so that they can inform the camper's parent. Refer all parents with questions about their camper directly to your leader.
6. Be aware if your camper has allergies or photo restrictions. Allergies and photo restrictions will be listed on their nametag. Your leader will inform you as well.
7. Make sure your camper only eats food they bring themselves or that is given to them by a camp leader.
8. Always make sure your camper is wearing a helmet and appropriate safety gear when utilizing the riding equipment.
9. If the moon-bounce deflates while you are inside, **calmly** assist the campers in safely exiting the moon-bounce.
10. Be timely and come prepared for a fun day of work. If you have any questions or concerns, speak to your leader immediately.
