

A Day in the Life of a White Shirt

- Arrive at camp at 8:00 am at your assigned area to:
 - Check in with your group leader for attendance
 - Assist with set-up
 - Receive your "buddy" assignment
- You will be partnered up with a camper, who will be your buddy for the day. You are responsible for making sure your buddy:
 - o Is having fun –Be playful and energetic
 - o Is safe – Your camper should never be more than an arms length away from you.
 - o Remains with the group at all times—Be sure you and your buddy are always with your group. Do not wander off alone.
 - o Eats their lunch – encourage them to finish everything they bring for lunch. Be sure they do not eat things from other campers or you because of possible allergies.
 - o Uses the restroom at pitstop breaks – You may NOT take a camper to the restroom by yourself. A camp staff person with a necklace must be present when campers use the restroom.
 - o Is not in any pictures if his/her name tag says "no photo"
 - o Be aware of allergies (these will be written on your "buddy's" name tag)
 - o Has all of their belongings throughout the day. You will rotate with your "buddy" and group through various fun-filled activities throughout the day. Be sure you take all their belongings with them.
 - o Is signed out before they leave. When it is time for campers to go home, make sure your "buddy's" parent/caregiver has signed him/her out with your leader and that the leader knows the camper is leaving. If a parent/caregiver asks you about your "buddy" please refer them to your leader.
- Once your buddy has been signed out:
 - Assist with clean-up of your assigned location
 - Check for trash on the fields, in classrooms, and empty the trash cans
 - Check in with your leader to see what else may be needed
 - Check in with your leader for attendance
- Your day at camp is done! Get some rest for another fun-filled day at camp!
